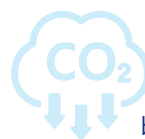

THE IMPACT OF ADOPTING THE CRUISE GUIDELINES



30% EMISSION REDUCTION

Simple, practical changes on board can reduce emissions by up to **30%**.



GREEN HVO

Green HVO can reduce greenhouse gas emissions by up to **80 - 90%**.



PROTECT WHAT LASTS

A properly maintained teak deck lasts **20-25 years**. Poor maintenance can reduce this by **5-15 years**.
